EARLY YEARS or EYFS =

Early Years Foundation Stage 1 = Nursery = 3+ years

Early Years Foundation Stage 2 = Reception = 4+ years

NURSERY =

3+ years = *Morning and Afternoon Classes*

RECEPTION =

4+ years = *Penguins and Chimps*

KEY STAGE 1 =

Year 1 = 5+ years = *Giraffes, Foxes and Peacocks*

and

Year 2 = 6+ years = *Aardvarks and Koalas*

KEY STAGE 2 =

Junior School - Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

INFANT =

Foundation Stage 2 (Reception) and Key Stage 1

YEARS =

JUNIOR =

Key Stage 2 = Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

ENHANCED RESOURCE

Provision for pupils with additional needs in a mainstream school (that is not a Special school).

Brackensdale Infant caters for children who have communication and language disorders and may have a diagnosis of Autism. All children in the Enhanced Resource have been assessed by the Local Authority. Each child's needs are set down and there are objectives for school staff to work towards during the child's time in the nursery and infant school.

There are approximately 6 Enhanced Resource places within each year group (Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2). The Ark is a specialist facility for children with autism.
